Students need to arrive by **9.00am** next Wednesday for school photos.

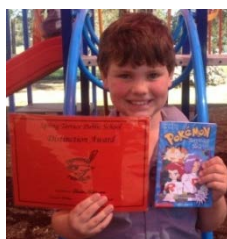

School swimming begins next Monday 11<sup>th</sup> Nov.

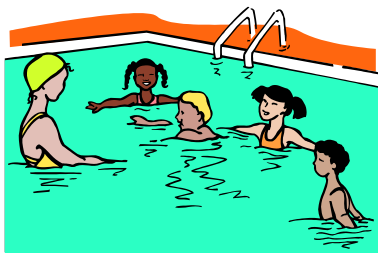
**Times:** 10:15 to 11:00
