Staff and Organisation

Our staff and their roles have stayed the same as they were for 2014. Mrs Barrett has 12 students in her K, 1, 2 class and there are 14 students in Mr Scott's 3 to 6 class.

Mrs PE will continue to do Library each Monday as well as teaching Science and Art to the primary class and fundamental movement skills to Mrs Barrett's class.

Mrs Pulling will be running the extended transition program for preschool aged children each Tuesday and providing learning support and doing some teaching each Monday.

Mrs Chapman will be working Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and every second Wednesday, looking after notes, payments, absences, assisting with uniforms and other general enquiries.

School Attendance and Absences

It is very important that students attend school regularly and arrive at school on time. If students have poor attendance or are regularly late the school is required to discuss this with parents and put an attendance program in place.

Late last year we changed over to a computerized roll marking system. Teachers will mark the roll by 9:30 each morning, if your child arrives after this time they will need a note to explain their absence from school. Absence slips are regularly sent home on the newsletter or can be found in the foyer and the office.

General Permissions

When students enrol parents are asked to fill out a general permission note regarding photographs of students appearing in the newsletter, school website and in stories in newspapers.

At present we have permission for all students in our school to appear in photographs both in print and on the web.

This note is valid until a student leaves the school. If as a parent you would like to change these permissions for your child please contact the school.
