Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN

Students in years 3 and 5 complete NAPLAN testing Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. While this is only one tool we use to assess students, school attainment and progress it is important that students are given their best opportunity to show what they have learnt. Parents can assist with this by ensuring that their children are well rested and arrive at school on time.

School attendance

One of the biggest predictors of success at school is student attendance. Statistics and experience tell us that students who attend school regularly achieve better results. Average attendance for NSW is 95%, this equates to 1 day off in 20, about 10 days per year. Please ensure that your children attend school every day unless they are not able to due to illness. Family events such as holidays can be worthwhile learning experiences but please consider the amount of time your child will be away from school when planning such events. It is also important that students arrive at school on time. The morning bell rings at 9:10am. Being late means students miss important work and it can be disruptive to the organisation of the class.

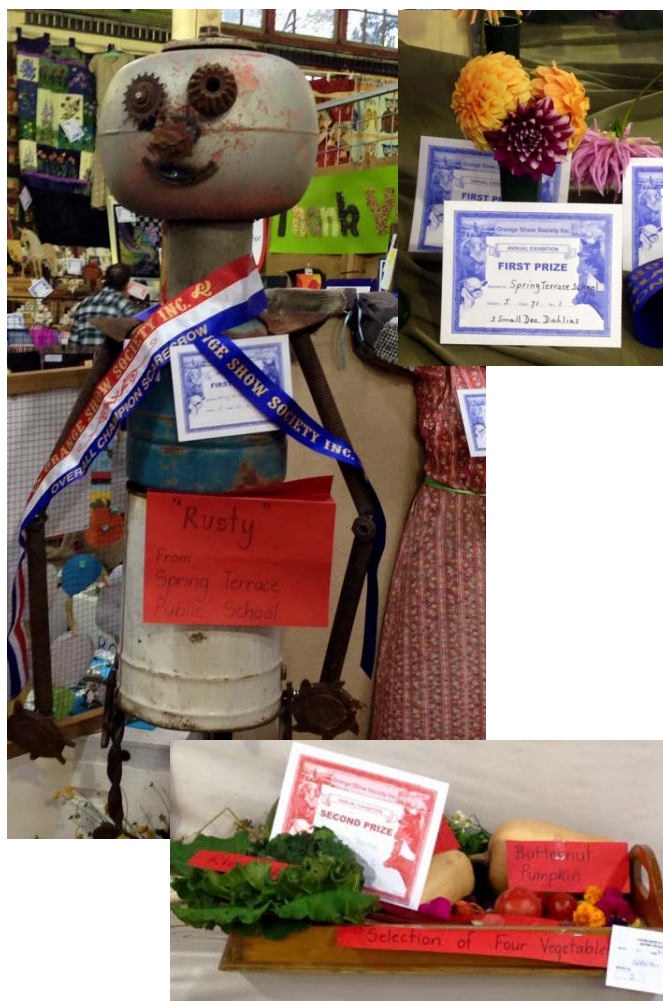
