*Literama* is an innovative drama programme designed for primary students

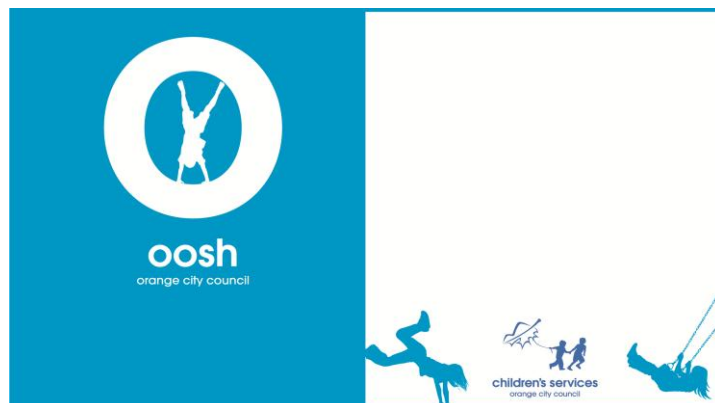
