Swimming this Wednesday

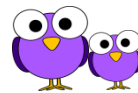
Swimming continues **this Wed 26 Oct** at the same time, 2.30-3.30pm. The children will travel in by bus and be collected by parents at **3.20pm**.

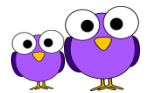
Count Us In – Next Thursday
