The NAPLAN results were updated on the MySchools website last week and were also reported in the CWD on Saturday. My Schools shows and the CWD reported that the students at **Spring Terrace School** are doing very well compared to the schools in Orange and in fact schools across Australia.

Our greatest achievements have been, the improvement students have shown between sitting NAPLAN in year 3 and then again in year 5.

Our best results were in reading and writing which were well above the state average, while our maths results were similar to the state average and schools similar to ours.

#### High Jump Training and Form Check at Spring Hill School – Tomorrow 16 March

Due to an injury to a student in recent years the rules regarding high jump regarding student safety have changed. The department rule is that if students are going to do the Fosbury Flop they must have a sign off from a coach.

Tomorrow there will be a high jump coach at Spring Hill from 9:00 until 12:00 who will be able to sign off on students to say that they are jumping safely and provide some coaching at the same time.

This is open to students who are 8 to 13 year olds and can jump or are close to the qualifying heights for the OSSA Carnival -Junior 95cm, 11s 100cm, Senior 105cm

Parents will need to drop students at Spring Hill by 9am and Mr Scott will bring them back to school.

Mr Scott will not be at Spring Hill so students will be responsible for themselves and their belongings and are expected to represent our school in the best possible manner. The coach Mrs Gayle Gordon is a teacher.
