#### **COLA Update**

We have lodged a 50/50 funding application with the department which was approved but is not yet funded. We were ready to start doing some of the work towards this ourselves using the funds we have and donated time and materials, unfortunately the department has changed the rules so that now such a structure can only be built through Public Works.

The result is that until our 50/50 grant is funded we won't be able to proceed with the COLA.


