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Camp Out & Welcome BBQ Friday 7th April

Our combined Camp Out and Welcome Barbeque is on this Friday 7th April. This will be a fun activity for students and a chance for our school community to get to know each other. Plans for the day.

- Students should come to school dressed for camping.
- We will make damper during the day and cook it over the fire for afternoon tea.
 Students may want to bring something to eat in addition to this. Usual routine for Friday recess and lunch.
- Parents and families are all welcome and can arrive any time in the afternoon. We would like some assistance putting up tents and manning the fire.
- Families attending are asked to bring a salad or dessert for dinner. The P&C will provide sausages, rissoles and bread and will have paper plates etc.
- Dinner will occur at about 6pm.
- As soon as it is dark enough we will put on a movie on the outdoor screen for the children. Children might like to bring a camp chair or beanbag.
- Breakfast will be cereal and milk.
- Students need to be collected by **9am** Saturday morning.

SAFETY

While we want everybody to enjoy themselves on Friday our first concern is student safety. The staff have completed a risk assessment to ensure we have considered possible risks and how we can minimise them.

Considerations include

Campfire- A teacher or nominated parent will be at and in charge of the fire at all times. Students will not be allowed near the fire or to put wood on it without this person's permission. No lit sticks etc. are to be taken away from the fire.

A hose will be ready at the fire connected to the tap at the bottom end of the vegetable gardens.

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Moving around in the dark.

Once it is dark students will not be allowed to run around or go into unlit areas of the school.

Supervision

Students are not to leave the school grounds without a teacher's knowledge. This includes with their parents.

Parents who are camping have to provide their WWCC number to the school.

Parents wishing to camp the night will have to have completed their "Working With Children Check". Please speak to Mr Scott as soon as possible if you need to do this and haven't.

Working With Children Check

It is now a requirement that anybody working with children, whether employed or voluntarily, needs a WWCC. This includes activities like our camp out. *If you are a volunteer it is free*.

The Steps

1. Got to or google WWCC

2. Fill out the online form and write down or print the number you are given.

3. Take the number to the NSW Services building in Kite St and prove who you are.
