Reading Support Program

Recently our school was lucky enough to receive some funding from Uniting Care to run a literacy support program for 2 hours three days a week for 10 weeks. The school is adding some funds to this so that the program will run until the end of term 3, 14 weeks in total. We have also decided to increase the time so that we can provide some additional mathematics support for this time as well.

The funds from Uniting Care along with the school funds will be used to employ a Student, Learning Support Officer or SLSO (teacher's aide) for three and a half hours, 3 days per week. In the mornings the SLSO will work with some students individually on the MultiLit program as well as working with the kindergarten students as a group and after recess the SLSO will provide in class maths support for students in both Mrs Barrett's and Mr Scott's classes.

This week we welcome Brianna Penrose who will be filling the SLSO role and providing learning support to some individuals and groups of students for the next 4 weeks.

S.T.E.M-Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics
