OSSA Athletics at Orange Waratah Sports Oval

The OSSA athletics carnival will take place next Monday 9th April at Orange Waratahs Sports Oval. Mr Scott and Miss Paige will attend the carnival and Mrs Pulling will stay at school to teach any primary students who don't attend or who return to school after their age race.

800 m events start at 8:45 am and will be followed by the age races, 200m and relays.

Students in the 800m will need to arrive by 8:30, all other students need to arrive by 9am.

There will be a canteen available on the day however it would be a good idea for students to bring at least some food and a water bottle. Students should wear their school sports uniform and their school hat.

Parents/Carers will be responsible for transporting their children to and from the carnival.

Cross Country

OSSA Cross Country is going to be held next Friday 13th April 2018. The reason for this is due to the district cross country being brought forward a month. In the event of poor weather conditions an announcement will be made on radio 2GZ at 8am or our school will be notified by phone before 9am. The backup date will be Tuesday 1st May 2018.

Cross country will be held at Cudal Showgrounds and involves all students from Kindergarten to Year 6. Infants run a 1km course while 8 to 10 year olds run 2km and 11 and 12 year olds run 3km.

The first 4 place getters in each division (with the exception of 5, 6, 7 year olds) will represent OSSA at the District PSSA Cross Country which will be held at Molong Golf Course on Friday 4th May. The 5th and 6th placegetters names will be taken as a reserve in case any of the first four place getters need to withdraw from the District carnival.

There will be full canteen facilities operating at the OSSA carnival. However, lunches must be preordered. Please find attached the order forms as these need to be filled out and returned to the front office by Friday 6th April 12pm. Orders received after this date and time will not be fulfilled.
