## Infant's Tabloid Day at Spring Hill

Thank you to all the Parents/Carers that have returned their child's lunch order form for the Tabloid Day to our front office by the due date of last Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> March. As previously notified no late orders will be accepted by the organisers as this is a larger event run by Spring Hill Public School. A copy of the lunch order form will be sent home so parents/carers can see which students need their lunches packed for the day.

Tabloids commence at 10am and finish at 2pm. K-2 students who have travelled to school by Bus will remain on the Bus to be joined by K-2 students who have been dropped off to school by **9AM.** If you happen to miss the morning bus please continue on to Spring Hill Public School.

The bus will collect K-2 students from Spring Hill at 3pm and collect primary students from Spring Terrace at the usual time.

Parents are welcome to stay and to drop off at 10am and pick up at 2pm if this suits.

#### **Bus Behaviour**

While the behaviour has been generally good on the bus we have recently had a few reports from Ryan to say that he has had to speak to students about moving out of their seat, crawling under seats, eating and annoying other students.

The staff have impressed upon the students that Ryan's job is to get them to school and home safely and he shouldn't have to be repeatedly reminding students to stay in their seat and to behave sensibly.

We ask parents/carers to join with us in regularly reminding children of safe, considerate behaviour while travelling on the bus.

## **ICAS Exams**

This year students will have the opportunity to sit ICAS exams. These exams are written by the University of NSW and are available for students from year 2 to year 7 in the following areas. The cost for each exam is as follows;

## Growth Mindset / Resilience Peer Support Programme

Last Friday we commenced our inaugural Peer Support Programme. Mrs Pulling and Mr Scott worked with the Peer Support Group Leaders in preparation for the first session and they performed admirably on the day.





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The first session involved students collectively watching a video on Growth Mindset and then breaking into their groups to complete a task where they compared fixed mindset statements versus growth mindset statements.



## Tennis Lessons

Tennis lessons with Alison Seib began last Friday and from all accounts the students thoroughly enjoyed their coaching sessions despite the unusually hot autumn day.
