### **Cross Country**

The district Cross Country Carnival has been planned for the first Friday of Term 2 therefore, OSSA is going to hold their cross country event on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2018. The reason for this is due to the district cross country being bought forward a month. In the event of poor weather conditions and announcement will be made on radio 2GZ at 8am or your school will be notified by phone before 9am. The backup date will be Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018.

Cross country is to be held at Cudal Showgrounds and involves all students from Kindergarten to Year 6. Infants run a 1km course while 8 to 10 year olds run 2km and 11 and 12 year olds run 3km.

The first 4 place getters in each division (with the exception of 5, 6, 7 year olds) will represent OSSA at the District PSSA Cross Country which will be held at Molong Golf Course on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May. The 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> placegetters names will be taken as a reserve in case any of the first four place getters need to withdraw from the District carnival.

There will be full canteen facilities operating at the OSSA carnival. However, lunches must be preordered. Please find attached the order forms as these need to be filled out and returned to the front office by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> April 12pm. Orders received after this date and time will not be fulfilled.
