As well as commercial treatments, it is suggested that parents use a nit comb and conditioner to physically remove them.

K/1 Classroom

In Mathematics, K/1 are learning about time. Kindergarten are learning about O'clock and telling the time on the hour. Year One are learning about O'clock, half-past and they are also being introduced to quarter past and quarter to. The children will be making their own clocks which they will be bringing home so they can practise telling time with their parents. In English, K/1 have started to do Literacy rotations. Children work individually or in pairs at each station and participate in reading with the teacher each day. These rotations focus on sight words, sentence structure and writing activities.

1/2 Classroom



3-6 Classroom

Over the coming weeks in English the Primary students will be reading and writing factual texts. This week we are researching Australia's pre-history. We will be practicing finding and checking information and writing it in our own words. In Maths, we are learning about numbers, this will include place value, prime and composite numbers and integers (positive and negative numbers).
