COVID Restrictions Remain at Level 3

Arrivals and departures

Uniform and SHOES

In 2019 it was decided to move away from our formal uniform and encourage students to wear the current shorts/trackpants and polo shirt. Providing students with a uniform that allowed them to move and play freely was an important factor in this decision. Black joggers were agreed upon as a part of this uniform.

Black joggers were chosen because:

- A. They are easy to find and match our uniform, and
- B. They allow students to participate in physical activity.

Recently quite a few our students have been wearing shoes that don't meet either of these requirements.

When you are next buying joggers for your children to wear to school, please buy black, well-fitting ones.

News from the Classrooms

K/1 Classroom

This week in Maths we are learning about 'Time'. Kinder are looking at the clock on the hour and Year 1 are looking at the clock on quarter to, quarter past, half hour and hour. In English, we are writing compound sentences using the correct punctuation.

Year 2 Classroom

Students are thoroughly enjoying our new novel study, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* by Roald Dahl. In Grammar, we are focusing on nouns, common nouns and proper nouns. Students have been focusing on identifying proper nouns in both their own and their peers writing. In Creative Arts, Year 2 are exploring 'self-portraits'. So far students have created a proportional self- portrait inspired by Bernini and are in the process of creating a self-portrait inspired by Roy Lichtenstein's infamous pop art.

Homework- I have attached a letter that contains an overview of what is happening this term. I have also attached a family tree. Could you please support your child to complete this, as we will be using this in our writing unit (autobiography). Thank you! Ms Toovey

3-6 Classroom

Today our class began reading the novel Misery Guts by Morris Gleitzman. In Grammar Years 3 and 4 are reviewing common and proper nouns, while years 5 and 6 are learning about verbal nouns. In the sentence "Isn't that a beautiful old building." "Building" is a verbal noun.

In Maths, we have been improving on our whole number skills and are starting on multiplication and division. Primary students have taken their homework home today.


