Conductive Hearing

The NSW Department of Education offers to schools via the local Hearing Support Team, Conductive Hearing lessons to students in Kinder to Year 2. Conductive Hearing Loss is a fluctuating hearing loss that affects many young children. It limits the conduction of sounds to the inner ear and is usually due to otitis media which is an infection of the middle ear. Around 30 - 40% of children under 6 years can have otitis media or a conductive hearing loss at any given time.

A Hearing Consultant is attending the school on Tuesday afternoon, 6 May to work with Miss Hutchison and the junior students in providing a lesson involving showing how to blow their nose correctly to help



keep their nose and ears clear. The lessons are conducted on an age-appropriate basis and are adapted to suit the target group.
